America's 10 Best Value Hotels this Fall:

1. **Hotel Hive – Washington, D.C. – *TripAdvisor pricing from \$231 per night this fall (45% savings, compared to the average city price in fall)***

Cool design elements of this micro hotel unite modern innovation with historic character. The prime location means Hotel Hive guests can buzz around the capital and then return to a unique room. A TripAdvisor reviewer commented, "Very modern and clean rooms, friendly staff and amazing value for money! If you are planning to visit Washington, D.C., this is the place to stay!"

2. **Lone Star Court – Austin, Texas – *TripAdvisor pricing from \$230 per night this fall (33% savings, compared to the average city price in fall)***

For travelers nostalgic for true travel adventures, this boutique hotel features an Austin and Texas Hill Country aesthetic. Lone Star Court is a true piece of Americana, pairing retro vibes with modern design twists.
