1. [Tara Lodge](#), Belfast - **£95 per night on TripAdvisor<sup>1</sup> this Autumn, 37% cheaper<sup>2</sup> than the average Autumn price for Belfast**

This small independent hotel offers 34 stylish, contemporary rooms of which many boast wonderful views overlooking the leafy avenues of South Belfast and the mountains beyond.

2. [Grasshoppers Hotel Glasgow](#), Glasgow - **£102 per night on TripAdvisor this Autumn, 27% cheaper than the average Autumn price for Glasgow**

Located in Glasgow City Centre, this hotel is positioned perfectly for exploring the city. In keeping with the historic feel of Glasgow, the rooms feature high ceilings, cornices and impressive windows and views.

3. [The Westbridge Hotel](#), London - **£119 per night on TripAdvisor this Autumn, 55% cheaper than the average Autumn price for London**

This boutique hotel offers its guests panoramic views of the Isle of Wight and the Purbecks and rooms are decorated in an opulent style for maximum luxury and comfort.
